WHAT ELSE IS ON YOUR RATES NOTICE

RUBBISH CHARGE

The rubbish charge per service has increased by 7.6% to \$376.68. The rubbish service includes the general rubbish bin as well as the recycling bin.

General rubbish is collected every Monday and recycling every second Tuesday.

EMERGENCY SERVICES LEVY

This is a charge collected on behalf of the State Government to help fund **Emergency Services. The State** Government increased the ESL for 2022/2023 to \$93 per rates notice.
