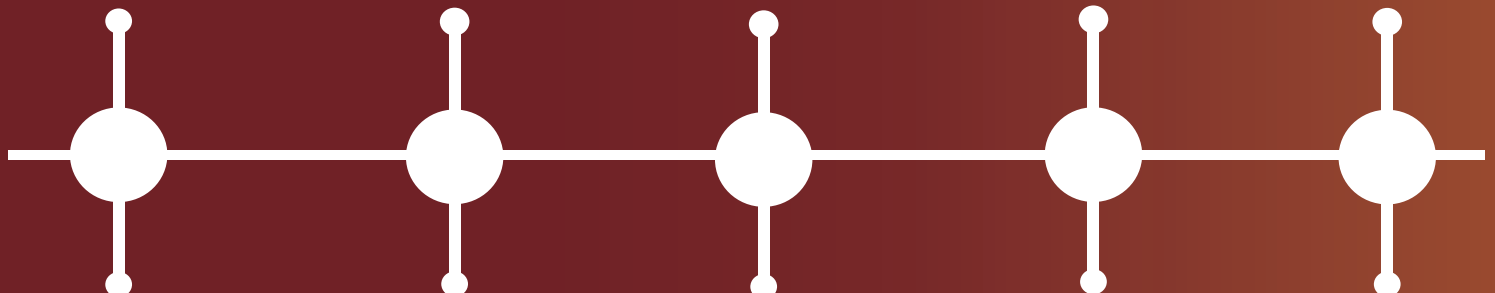

UNDERSTANDING YOUR RATES CHARGES

Step 1

Total rates required to run the Local Government



Cost of running the Local Government

Minus non-rate revenue (grants, fees and charges, other)

To calculate rate revenue required

Step 2

Rate in dollar calculated



Divide the rates revenue required

By the combined rental value of all rateable properties

To calculate the rate in the dollar

Step 3

What you pay



By your property's value as set by the Valuer General - either Gross Rental Value (GRV) or Unimproved Value (UV)

Multiply the rate in the dollar

To Calculate your rates for the year

Your 2022/2023 rates may be affected by the State Government's (Valuer General) property revaluations

WHAT ELSE IS ON YOUR RATES NOTICE

RUBBISH CHARGE

The rubbish charge per service has increased by 7.6% to \$376.68. The rubbish service includes the general rubbish bin as well as the recycling bin.

General rubbish is collected every Monday and recycling every second Tuesday.

EMERGENCY SERVICES LEVY

This is a charge collected on behalf of the State Government to help fund Emergency Services. The State Government increased the ESL for 2022/2023 to \$93 per rates notice.
