WHAT NOT TO PUT IN MY RECYCLE BIN

AVON WASTE

Steel and aluminum cans (excluding aerosol cans)

Cardboard boxes & cartons

Liquid paperboard cartons (milk, juice & laundry detergent)

Newspaper and print

All plastic containers (Empty with lid off)

Including all marked numbers

- Soft Plastics** (scrunchable)
- Glass** (See reverse for glass recycling options)
- Green waste** (Belongs in the waste bin or deliver to the waste transfer station)
- Polystyrene** (Belongs in the waste bin)
- Food scraps** (Belongs in the waste bin)
- Nappies** (Belongs in the waste bin)
