Regular Waste and Recycling Service:

- Place your bins out the night before collection day
- Lids must open towards the road
- Bins must be placed 50cm apart
- Christmas Day is the only public holiday that will affect your collection – Check Avon Waste or Shire websites www.narembeen.wa.gov.au

WHAT CAN GO INTO MY RECYCLE BIN

Steel and aluminium cans (including aerosol cans)
 Cardboard boxes & cartons
 Newspaper and print
 Liquid paperboard cartons (milk, juice & laundry detergent)
 All plastic containers (empty with labels on)

Including all marked numbers

WHAT NOT TO PUT IN MY RECYCLE BIN

- Soft (scrunchable) Plastics (Belongs in the waste bin)
- Glass (See reverse for glass recycling options)
- Green waste (Belongs in the waste bin or deliver to the waste transfer station)
- Polystyrene (Belongs in the waste bin)
- Food scraps (Belongs in the waste bin)
- Nappies (Belongs in the waste bin)

WHAT TO PUT IN YOUR RECYCLING

- **Cardboard** – clean, flattened boxes and cartons
- **Paper** – clean, untied newspaper, magazines, paper, envelopes, telephone books
- **Plastic** – clean and empty bottles and containers marked with 1, 2 or 3
- **Aluminium** – clean cans, tins and foil
- **Steel** – clean cans, tins and aerosol cans
- **Liquid paperboard** – clean milk, juice and laundry detergent cartons

COMMUNITY RECYCLING

NAREMBEEN LIONS CLUB

- **NEWSPAPERS** - kerbside pick up as per calendar on reverse
 - **GLASS** - drop your glass in the drums provided at the Latham Road drop off point opposite the Roadhouse

NAREMBEEN MEN'S SHED

- **ALUMINIUM CANS** - drop your aluminium cans into the cages provided at Narembeen's various recreation facilities or drop off at the Latham Road drop off point opposite the Roadhouse
- For further information - Warren, Men's Shed 9064 8049*

LATHAM ROAD DROP OFF POINT – AREA TO BE KEPT TIDY AND FREE FROM GENERAL RUBBISH – ONLY RECYCLABLE GLASS AND ALUMINIUM IS ACCEPTED

NAREMBEEN CRC

- **MOBILE PHONES, MOBILE PHONE BATTERIES & CHARGERS** - may be dropped off for recycling
 - **USED PRINTER CARTRIDGES** - certain brands of printer cartridges can be dropped off for recycling

BULK WASTE

- May be taken to the Shire Waste Transfer Station, see details opposite.
 - Please separate waste to recycle from waste for disposal
 - Please follow directions from the facility operator
 - Disposal fees may apply for certain types of bulk waste.

GREEN WASTE

- If you cannot use your green waste, deliver it to the Shire Waste Transfer Station, details opposite.

WHAT NOT TO PUT IN YOUR RECYCLING

- **Greenwaste** – grass clippings, garden cuttings, leaves and soil
- **Food Scraps**
- **Styrofoam and polystyrene**
- **Electrical goods** – computers, mobiles, e-waste etc
- **Nappies**
- **Steel products** – except steel cans
- **Glass** – bottles and jars (see below for recycling options)
- **Plastic Bags**

WHAT NOT TO PUT IN YOUR RUBBISH BIN

- Hot or burning ashes
- Bricks, rocks or soil
- Paints or solvents
- Hazardous material, asbestos or chemicals
- Liquid waste

WASTE TRANSFER STATION

Narembeen South Road

OPEN: Tues, Fri, Sat, Sun: 10am-4pm

CLOSED: Good Friday and Christmas Day

Please separate your waste appropriately for disposal and recycling.

Cover and secure your load during transport. Talk to the facility operator about disposal of waste.

Transfer Station facilities include:

- Recycle bins – see recycling guide opposite
- Bulk domestic waste bins
- Cardboard only bin
- Scrap metal area
- Glass bins
- Used engine oil vessel
- Building rubble area
- Aluminium cans
- Green waste area
- Timber products area
- Car battery collection

Commercial loads incur fees – contact the Shire office for information. If you need to dispose of asbestos please call the Shire of Narembeen on **9064 7308** for conditions of disposal and to arrange a disposal time/date at the landfill.

drumMUSTER

drumMUSTER is the national program that has been set up for the collection and recycling of cleaned, eligible, non-returnable crop production and on-farm animal health chemical containers. Eligible drums can be taken to the Waste Transfer Station and processed by the facility operator.

Remember to partake in drumMUSTER your drums must be triple rinsed and dry before delivery! www.drummuster.com.au
