





Don't forget our Children's Week Event is happening soon! Join us for a Magic Party, there will even be a magician there! See the poster for more information.



Hello,

We hope everyone is well.

It has been quite steady of late. We were called out to a serious traffic crash on Mount Walker Road. It was a crash which could have had a horrific outcome for all involved. Fortunately, the four occupants were able to get clear from the crash site before the vehicle caught fire.

A big thank you to those bystanders first on scene, SJA and DFES who attended and were able to help the occupants and take control of the scene. It is much appreciated. Inquiries are still continuing in relation to the cause of the crash.



There has been a series of diesel thefts in the Wheatbelt District, areas targeted so far include Wongan Hills and Cunderdin. Please be alert to any suspicious vehicles and report them. Ensure your diesel fuel is well secured.

OFFICIAL

We have received a report of a vehicle being driven inside the Wadderin Wildlife Sanctuary without consent. Please report any suspicious behaviour in this area to us.

We were called out to Marvel Lock to assist Southern Cross for a Missing Persons case. There were serious welfare concerns held for this person. A mobile phone triangulation showed the Missing Person was with in a 200 km radius, still a very large area to search. Airwing assisted during the search.

The Missing Person made contact on his mobile phone with Merredin Police but was gravely unwell in the heat and unable to give his exact location, except to say he was near a water tank with his vehicle nearby him. Shortly thereafter, while patrolling we sighted a water tank on Old Marvel Lock Road but could still not find the male person. We activated our siren and Merredin Police advised they could hear the siren in the background while talking to the male person, so we knew we were close by.

We took a few 4WD back tracks and located the vehicle with the male person lying under a tree about 20 metres away in a poor state of health and provided him first aid. SJA attended the scene and took good care of him. It was a pleasing outcome which could have had a dire outcome.

During the King's Birthday Long Weekend, we conducted 207 RBTs. It was great to see no one blew over and everyone was driving in a responsible manner. We did however issue one speeding infringement on Mount Walker Road.

The maintenance and works at Narembeen Police Station have been postponed until Monday 2 October. We will be working out of Bruce Rock Police Station for approximately 3 weeks.





"Then I found a good Kelpie, had a few puppies, and now I've just retired."


The man is amazed. He goes back into the house and asks the owner how much he wants for the dog.




