



I don't know about hurt to help- it looks more like torture!

Some of you may not be aware, but we have one super bloke who is prepared to put his body on the line, repeatedly, in order to help others.

Ethan Stirrat, elder son of Lynda and Scott, is in the final year of his medical degree and has spent the last year in Karratha at their hospital. In his role he sees many cases of the unfortunate positions that some people find themselves in and for the last 3 years has wanted to contribute in a positive way. Wanting to raise funds to help people, he wanted to ensure that 100% of the funds people donated to his activities went to the needy recipients, so decided that the only way to achieve that was by establishing his own charity and so "Hurt To Help" was born.

He raises money by putting his body through trials that we mere mortals can only marvel at. Earlier this year he ran in the Pilbara 24hour marathon and completed 160kms in 24 hour (nearly 7 kms an hour every hour for 24 hours) and distributed funds to a needy cause. He has continued this in October and completed his Stoictober with an agenda that is mindboggling- and this is all for other people! His aim in October was to do a total of 500km, 6000 pullups, 12000 pushups and 12000 sit ups! This breaks down to an average day of 16km followed by 200 pull ups, 400 push-ups and 400 sit-ups every day for the month. Yes, it is unbelievable and yes Ethan did achieve this.

Ethan, being our local hero, is launching his "Hurt to Help" Foundation in Narembeen on Saturday 2nd Dec at the Narembeen Recreation Centre and would love to have you there as he launches his dream. 



Christmas Light Tour






