APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. This application form is for the disposal of contaminated waste at the Bendering Tip.
- 2. Please complete the application form in full and return it via email to roeeho@corrigin.wa.gov.au
- 3. Please carefully read the waste disposal conditions on the back of this form.
- 4. Please be advised that a <u>notice period of 3 days</u> is required before disposal. After you have submitted the application form you will be contacted by phone to confirm a suitable time and date for the disposal.
- 5. Once your application form has been processed and a disposal date and time confirmed you will then be issued a Disposal Permit. You will need to bring a copy of the Disposal Permit with you to the Bendering Tip on the date of disposal.
- 6. Once you have received your Disposal Permit you will be able to organise payment. All payments are made through the Shire of Corrigin Finance Officer.

CONDITIONS OF DISPOSAL

The Applicant understands fully and will comply with the following conditions as set out below:

- 1. Asbestos waste must be double wrapped in heavy duty polythene plastic of at least 0.2mm thickness and sealed with tape to prevent the asbestos fibres from entering the atmosphere.
- 2. Asbestos waste must have "CAUTION ASBESTOS" clearly labelled with letters not less than 50mm high on wrapping.
- 3. Asbestos waste must be disposed of intact (no sliding off trucks and the like which could damage wrapping):
 - Manual Handling bundles are to contain no more than 3 sheets per bundle.
 - Mechanical Handling bundles are to contain no more than 20 sheets per bundle.
- 4. Tipping of loads will not be allowed. Hauler/carrier will be responsible for off-loading the asbestos/contaminated material. There is no assistance available by the landfill staff or machinery.
- 5. Broken and unstable asbestos is to be contained in heavy duty plastic bags (200microns thick minimum) that have been sealed and clearly labelled as containing asbestos. It is recommended that Bulka Bags be used to prevent tearing of the wrappings if the asbestos contains any jagged edges.
- 6. ALL packaging materials must be protected and remain intact during transport and disposal. Any packaging that has been damaged in transit must be replaced or repaired prior to disposal of the consignment.
- 7. All loads will be inspected for compliance by the Environmental Health Officer.
