Swimming pool flooring



We are pleased to share that the pool building now has an epoxy coating over the floor in the main walkway and all wet areas. The epoxy coating is a substantial aesthetic improvement and offers added safety to pool visitors by significantly reducing the risk of slipping.

Road Construction Works



Preliminary works on Coverley Road have been completed in preparation for gravel resheeting between SLK 3.2 and 8.96. This project is funded through the Roads to Recovery program.

On Monday, the crew commenced gravel re-sheeting works on Yeoman's Road (SLK 15.13 to 21.00) as part of a Roads to Recovery project.

Key worker housing project

The Shire has completed preliminary arrangements to acquire the vacant block of land at 5 & 7 Currall Street from Go Narembeen. This is a key step to enable the Shire to progress with lobbying and applying for grant funding for the construction of multiple key-worker houses in future years. This project will be vital for the expansion of industry and assurance of key services for Narembeen into the future.

In exchange for the land Council has endorsed lifting the caveat currently registered on the Narembeen Roadhouse, allowing Go Narembeen additional resources and options as they pursue their goals for the benefit of the district.

We would like to thank Go Narembeen for their willingness to work with Council and allow the progression of the key worker housing project.
