



LOCAL LAWS

In terms of the Local Government Act (1995) a local government may make local laws prescribing all matters that are required or permitted to be prescribed by a local law, or are necessary or convenient to be so prescribed, for the local government to perform any of its functions under this Act.

The Shire of Narembeen has several local laws which are currently under review:-

- Emu Hill Public Cemetery Reserve By-Laws 1928 as amended.
- By-Law No 15 – Relating to Fencing 1965
- Adoption of Draft Model By-Laws relating to Standing Orders No 4 1979
- By-Laws Relating to Pest Plants 1981
- By-Laws Relating to Dogs 1983
